“live our faith” it will grow stronger and help us to stand firm against sin.

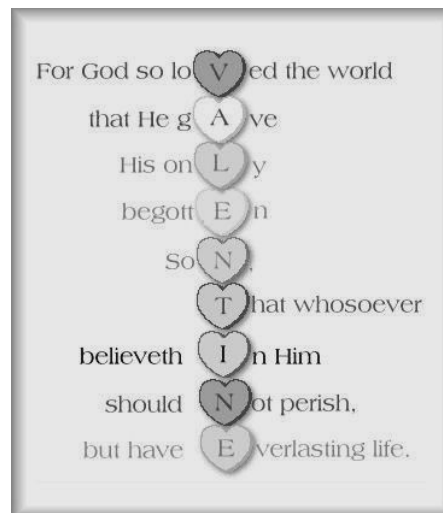
This month is heart month. Let us be reminded that we must be continually cleaning out our hearts so that they are healthy.
